Rippa Rugby World Cup

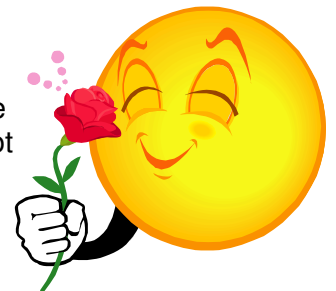
